The January suppers are on the way and moving to Friday nights this year. Hopefully more people might be able to attend. We are always looking for help.



We also have Bibles for your purchase. With the New Year approaching, we know that many of you will turn to your Bibles as you set your goals and priorities for 2013.


As always, your Diaconate continues to welcome and appreciate your comments and feedback as we strive to address the spiritual needs of all congregants.


